Welcome to the ninth annual Great Salt Lake Fringe Festival, and our first at Trolley Square! As always, we have an incredible line-up of performing artists this year, and we hope you enjoy experiencing a variety of innovative theatre while exploring all the dining, shopping, and entertainment that Trolley Square has to offer.

If you're new to Fringe, or just need a refresher, here's how it works: Over two weekends, dozens of performing arts companies perform original, cuttingedge work in our pop-up venues. Everything is under an hour. Shows are uncensored, self-rated, and unadjudicated. Explore the program, buy tickets online or at our box office, and get your Fringe on!

Our box office is located at Trolley Square in suite C104 which is just west of the Trolley Square water tower and next to the Trolley Wing Co trolley car. The Box office opens one hour before shows start each day.

This year's Fringe venues are located on Trolley Square's West Plaza and Design Row, and all of the venues are a short 2-minute walk from the box office. We highly recommend skipping the box office and buying tickets online to guarantee seats! Fringe shows often sell out or go to standing room only in the smaller venues.


